2014 Garden Tractor Pull Rules


- Hitch Height Maximum 13 inches
- Wheelie Bar 6" x 6"
- Maximum RPM 4000 stock; 5000 stock altered. RPM above 4200 must Have kill switch, blanket or 1/8" guard, main & safety hooks and helmet, if running alcohol must be in full suit, no exceptions
- Stock classes: 26/12/12 tires (no cut, sharpened or pro pulling tires)
- Modified & Stock Altered Tractors will participate in their designated classes
- Jr Farm Tractor & King of the Lawn will be stock only
- Engines must be available from the factory in that brand for stock class
- Engines must have OEM Flywheels
- Engines in stock classes must not run on racing fuel or alcohol (this type of fuel will be accepted in stock altered or modified classes only)
- Weights will extend no further than 12" from the frame of the tractor (18" in stock altered) (weights must be securely attached; no sitting on weights or weights under feet)
- Dropped weights will disqualify the pulling attempt.
- Tractors may be driven by only 2 different drivers for each class
- Helmets, shoes and long pants must be worn by those 12 years and under no exceptions.
- Drivers will keep one hand on the steering wheel at all times
- Drivers will remain seated at all times
- Drivers must wear appropriate footwear (shoes or sneakers)
- Jr Farm Tractors are limited to one complete set of factory weights
- King of the Lawn Class allows mowing deck
- Once the class has started, sign up ends
- First Puller has the option to refuse the first pull and drop to third for another attempt. This will become the recorded pull
- Drivers may stop before the 25 foot line and re-pull (at the discretion of the track official(s))
- All drivers must stay within the boundary lines
- Drivers must be ready to pull when it is their turn. If they are not in line and ready to pull they must go to the end of the class. Missing this pull will result in forfeiture of their hook fee.
- Any tractor determined to be Modified or stock altered will be placed in it's appropriate class.
- All decisions made on the track are final. There will be no discussion or protest.
- All points remain with the puller in the event their tractor becomes inoperable
- Attendance is required on 7 or more pull dates to be qualified for points
