

ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULL RULES

- 1. The contest is open to stock block agricultural tractors with rubber tires. No duals, tire studs, chains. Cut tires are allowed only in 8 mph classes.
- 2. Tractors to have stock appearing fuel systems.
- 3. Drawbar minimum length is to be 18 inches from the center of the rear wheel to the point of hook and 20 inches from the ground. All hydraulic drawbars must be pinned. The hook must be free hanging unless it is a stock hitch.
- 4. Exhaust must discharge upwards, unless tractor is equipped with factory underslung exhaust.
- 5. All tractors to be equipped with workable brakes. All tractors must have a hood and grill in place.
- 6. Any loss of weight, parts, or any other items during the pull will result in disqualification. All weights must be secured, and no weights will be allowed on the driver's platform.
- 7. Operators must always keep at least one hand on the steering wheel and be always seated while the tractor is in motion.
- 8. The flagger has the right to stop the pull at any time.
- 9. No implements are permitted on the tractors.
- 10. Weight determined by the scales will be the "official" weight at the pull.
- 11. Tractors that have been modified from their stock state will be moved to the enhanced classes. Track officials will make determinations as necessary.
- 12. 4 mph limit for stock tractors.
- 13. If you pull more than once and place, you will only receive the highest place award.
- 14. 4 mph classes 15.5-38 or 16.9-34 maximum tires up to 5500 lbs, 6500 through 8500 maximum tire size is 18.4-38
- 15. Wheelie bars are highly recommended, but not mandatory in the 4 mph classes.

Please sign up in the correct class to avoid conflict. You know if your tractor is stock.

General Rules

- 1. There will be no alcoholic beverages in the pits or on the show grounds.
- 2. Any puller under 18 years of age must have a 4H Driver's Certificate or their parent's consent and parents must sign a consent form in person at the time of registration. Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Children must be accompanied by an adult while in the pits. A child's feet need to reach the clutch pedal. Child pull restriction is 2nd gear maximum.
- 3. Registration closes once the class starts.
- 4. Pullers are allowed 2 attempts and 25 feet to start the sled.
- 5. Tractors must remain within the track boundaries during a pull or else be disqualified.
- 6. A pull is considered over when the forward movement of the sled has stopped. Currently, pullers are asked to stop their tractors when they are flagged by the end flagman.
- 7. The first puller in each class has the right to take that pull or drop three places an d pull again.
- 8. All pullers are responsible to know when they are pulling in each class, and if they feel that they cannot make it to the line when they are due, it is their responsibility to let an official know so they can be dropped to last place. If the driver is not there when it is his turn to pull, he will automatically be dropped to last place.
- 9. Tractors to be weighted according to class with a 100 lb. overweight allowance.
- 10. Drivers are expected to operate their tractor in a safe manner on the track, in the pits, and on the show grounds.
- 11. All pulls are to start from a tight hitch. No jerking the sled to get started or you will be DQ
- 12. Only 2 driver per tractor are allowed per class.
- 13. Prior to the tractor pulling, a drivers' meeting will be called to discuss pulling procedures and rules. All drivers must attend!
- 14. Decisions by the pull officials are final.
- 15. All puller must pay a \$10 fee for membership card (the card is good for a year)
- 16. All puller must go over the scales after they pull or they are DQ

Enhanced Tractor Rules

- 1. Basic antique rules apply.
- 2. Enhanced tractors are all non-stock antique tractors.
- 3. Enhanced tractors should have a kill switch.
- 4. Wheelie bars are mandatory.
- 5. Pullers have the choice of any gear to pull in.
- 6. 8 mph max speed.
- 7. Cut tires are allowed (max size 18.4-38)
